 This course is designed for a PIO assigned to an incident as a member of an AHIMT, Local IMT's, as well as for the PIO assigned to an incident as an assistant PIO in a variety of capacities. This course will help students develop a strong set of core PIO skills and the ability to apply them within the context of an AHIMT. This course combines elements from both the basic and advanced function to concentrate training on the fundamental duties and responsibilities of an PIO in an all-hazard environment. Exercises, simulations, discussions, and a final exam enable students to process and apply their new knowledge.
